Psalm 103 Discussion Questions

Psalm 103:1-5

- 1. What does it mean to "bless the Lord?"
- 2. What are the 5 benefits that David doesn't want us to forget?
- 3. How can these benefits fuel our thankfulness? And how should we go about "not forgetting" these things?

Psalm 103:6-14

- 1. What two attributes of God do we see in verse 6? And why is this comforting?
- 2. What did God do in verse 7? What would have happened if God didn't do that?
- 3. What attributes of God do we learn about in verses 8-14? What kind of word pictures are used in these verses? Which of these verses impacts you the most, and why?

Psalm 103:15-19

- 1. What do verses 15-16 teach about what mankind is like? How does that make you feel?
- 2. After hearing about how short our lives are, why should God's love (v.17-18) cause us to feel comforted?
- 3. What does verse 19 teach us about what God is like? What are the illustrations he uses? What would be different if these things weren't true about God?

Psalm 103:20-22

- 1. After reading through verses 1-19, how does David want everyone to respond? What groups does he want to bless the Lord?
- 2. What does it mean to "bless the Lord?" And what does "Oh my soul" mean?
- 3. Why do you think David is so passionate about blessing the Lord? From this psalm, what will you work on being more thankful for?
