

Discussion Questions & Application:

1. In Revelation there are interludes between seals 6 & 7, trumpets 6 & 7, bowls 6 & 7. Why are these important? How do these help believers while reading about God's judgment and wrath?
2. Observation skills: Some believe the "strong angel" in ch. 10 is Jesus. Why? What evidence is there that it is not Jesus?
3. What is the significance of the angel having one foot on the sea and the other foot on the land? What comfort does this bring when it appears that the world is out of control?
4. Why was John told not to write down the words spoken by the seven peals of thunder? [See Dan. 8:26; 12:4, 9] Memorize Deut. 29:29. Why might God choose not to reveal everything to us? How does this comfort you when things in life don't make sense and God chooses not to tell you why they are happening?
5. What does it mean in verse 6 that there will be "delay no longer," and in verse 7 that "the mystery of God is finished"? How is this possible when we still have the 7 bowl judgments (chapter 16)? What does this tell you about God's plan for and control of human history? What about His plan for your life?
6. Why was John told to eat the little book? [See Jer. 15:16; Ezek. 2:8; 3:1-3] Why would it be sweet as honey in his mouth but bitter in his stomach? What implications does this have for us, our attitude toward witnessing, and our compassion for those who don't repent?
7. God clearly has a timetable for the end of human history as we know it. Why has He delayed judging the world for so long? Read Ezek. 18:23, 32; 33:11; 1 Tim. 2:24; 2 Pet. 3:9; Rev. 2:21. What does this teach you about the heart of God? Do you have His heart for the world? If not, why not?
8. Get the Summer Nights at the Bridge fliers and invite 10 people to join you on July 23 & 30. Pray that God will open their eyes to the gospel. With the heart of God for lost people, go to one or more of the remaining weekly outreach opportunities associated with Summer Nights.
