

Discussion & Application:

1. Revelation 17-18 describes the details of the 7th bowl judgment on Babylon (cf. 16:19). What is the difference between the Babylon (woman / great harlot) of chapter 17 and the Babylon of chapter 18?
2. Who is the beast? What is the meaning of 7 heads (or mountains or kings – vv. 9-10) and 10 horns (or kings – v. 12) on the beast? How do Daniel chapters 2 & 7, and Rev. 13:1 help us understand the symbolism?
3. Who is the originator of false religions in the world? Why do we often find elements of truth in world religions and cults? What characteristics have you observed in false religions and cults? Why are people so easily misled by false religions and cults (cf. Eph. 2:1-3; 4:17-19; 2 Cor. 4:3-4; Jn. 3:19-20)?
4. What characteristics of the 7-year Tribulation will make it desirable for people to unite under a one-world religion? Why will people unite against Christianity during that time even to the point of martyring true followers of Jesus?
5. What does it mean that the beast was and is not and is about to come up out of the abyss and go to destruction? (See Rev. 13:1-4) How does this relate to the beast being the 7th and 8th king in Rev. 17:10-11?
6. What is the relationship between the 10 kings and the beast in verses 12-13? What power and authority do they give to the beast? Why will they turn on and destroy the harlot (v. 16)? What will this allow the beast to do (see Dan. 11:36-39; 2 Thess. 2:3-4)?
7. How does Rev. 17 encourage true followers of Jesus to make a stand against false religion(s) no matter what the cost?
8. Walter Martin, author of “Kingdom of the Cults,” famously asked, “**Are you willing to do for the truth what the cults do for a lie?**” What did he mean by that? What is your answer to the question? What specifically will that look like for the rest of your life? What will it look like this week?

¹ Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying, “Come here, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters, ² with whom the kings of the earth committed *acts of* immorality, and those who dwell on the earth were made drunk with the wine of her immorality.”

³ And he carried me away in the Spirit into a wilderness; and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast, full of blasphemous names, having seven heads and ten horns. ⁴ The woman was clothed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls, having in her hand a gold cup full of abominations and of the unclean things of her immorality, ⁵ and on her forehead a name *was* written, a mystery, “BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.” ⁶ And I saw the woman drunk with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the witnesses of Jesus.

When I saw her, I wondered greatly. ⁷ And the angel said to me, “Why do you wonder? I will tell you the mystery of the woman and of the beast that carries her, which has the seven heads and the ten horns. ⁸ The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to come up out of the abyss and go to destruction. And those who dwell on the earth, whose name has not been written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, will wonder when they see the beast, that he was and is not and will come. ⁹ Here is the mind which has wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains on which the woman sits, ¹⁰ and they are seven kings; five have fallen, one is, the other has not yet come; and when he comes, he must remain a little while. ¹¹ The beast which was and is not, is himself also an eighth and is *one* of the seven, and he goes to destruction. ¹² The ten horns which you saw are ten kings who have not yet received a kingdom, but they receive authority as kings with the beast for one hour. ¹³ These have one purpose, and they give their power and authority to the beast. ¹⁴ These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him *are the* called and chosen and faithful.”

¹⁵ And he said to me, “The waters which you saw where the harlot sits, are peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues. ¹⁶ And the ten horns which you saw, and the beast, these will hate the harlot and will make her desolate and naked, and will eat her flesh and will burn her up with fire. ¹⁷ For God has put it in their hearts to execute His purpose by having a common purpose, and by giving their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God will be fulfilled. ¹⁸ The woman whom you saw is the great city, which reigns over the kings of the earth.”
