

Discussion & Application:

1. What does “**hallelujah**” mean? Look up each of the 24x it occurs in Psalms. Why should people Praise Yahweh. What motivates you to praise Yahweh? How do you express your praise to Him? Verbally? Physically?
2. The first reason people on earth praise Yahweh in Ps. 104:35 is the same as the first reason beings will praise Him in heaven in Rev. 19:1-2. What is it? Do you have a difficult time with that reason? Why or why not?
3. The Bible says that God takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked (Ezek. 33:11), yet Rev. 19 tells us to praise Him when the wicked are judged. How do we reconcile those two?
4. For John (exiled on Patmos) and the people reading his inspired writings (severely persecuted), how would knowledge of this coming judgment of God help them?
5. What is the second reason beings in heaven praise Yahweh in Rev. 19:3? Why do people rebel against God’s authority? When you rebel against God (we all do every time we sin), what rationalizations go through your mind? Knowing that all rebellion will end one day, what should we do about specific areas of rebellion in our lives right now?
6. Is your life is characterized by praising Yahweh? How do you praise Him in private? In public? In church? Is it obvious to others why you are praising Him? Does your praise motivate others to say “Amen!” and join in praising Him with you? If not, what might you do differently to motivate others to join you?
7. Look at the similes in Rev. 19:6. What do they all imply about the way beings worship Yahweh in heaven? (See also Rev. 5:12; 7:10; 11:15) What keeps us from doing the same?
8. Jesus will return and reign physically on earth. When He does, will you be judged for your sins, or will you trust in Jesus and the judgment He endured in your place? If you haven’t already, turn from sin and trust in Jesus alone today. Then tell others to do the same before it is too late.
