

Discussion & Application:

1. Note that Rev. 19:9 and 19:17 both have invitations to a “supper.” What are the similarities and differences?
2. What do you know about the Battle of Armageddon? Where will it be? Why is it called that? (See Rev. 14:17-20; 16:12-16; 17:14; Is. 63; Joel 3:12-14; Micah 4; Zech. 14; Mt. 24:27-28)
3. Read Ezekiel 38-39. How many connections can you find between those two chapters and the passage in Rev. 19?
4. Why describe the angel as “standing in the sun” and that “he cried out with a loud voice”? Why does he summon the birds before the battle even begins? What does that tell us?
5. Some think God’s judgment on the bodies of His slain enemies at Armageddon is extreme. In what sense is this a just judgment? Cf. Ex. 21:23-25; Lev. 24:19-20; Deut. 19:21; Rev. 11:7-11.
6. This final battle before the Millennium will be in Israel. Why will the Antichrist and rulers of the world gather against Israel? What signs do you see today of the world being against Israel?
7. Is the battle in Rev. 19 the same as with Gog & Magog in Rev. 20? Why or why not?
8. What does God accomplish through the Battle of Armageddon? What impact will this have on the nation of Israel? Cf. Ezek. 38:23; 39:21ff; Zech. 12-14.
9. The beast (Antichrist) and false prophet thought they had it all. Where do they end up? How long will they be there? How long will their suffering last?
10. How does understanding what will happen when Jesus returns help you face the problems in our world today? Give specific applications to your thoughts, attitudes, words, and actions.
11. Who do you know that needs salvation from God’s coming wrath? Pray for them and plan a time to tell them Who Jesus is and What He has done for them. Call them to repent and believe.

a. The Supper of God (17-18)

¹⁷ Then I saw an angel standing in the sun, and he cried out with a loud voice, saying to all the birds which fly in midheaven, “Come, assemble for the great supper of God,¹⁸ so that you may eat the flesh of kings and the flesh of commanders and the flesh of mighty men and the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them and the flesh of all men, both free men and slaves, and small and great.”

b. The Seizure of the Beast (19-20)

¹⁹ And I saw the beast and the kings of the earth and their armies assembled to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.

²⁰ And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image; these two were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.

c. The Sword and the Feast (21)

²¹ And the rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse, and all the birds were filled with their flesh.
