 - Recognize that it is God’s will for you to proclaim the gospel (2 Tim. 1:1; 2 Cor. 5:17-21).
 - Pursue having a clear conscience at the end of every day (2 Tim. 1:3; Acts 20:26-27).
 - Preach the gospel to yourself every day. Let God’s grace motivate you (Tit. 2:11-14).
 - Spend time in the WOG and prayer (Col. 3:16-17).
 - Ask others to pray for you (Rom. 15:30-32; Eph. 6:19-20; Col. 4:2-4; 2 Thess. 3:1-2; 2 Cor. 1:8-11).
 - Share your faith as a lifestyle, no matter what the cost. Determine ahead of time you are more than willing to suffer for the gospel (Acts 20:24).
 - Train others to do the same. Pass the baton to the next generation (2 Tim. 2:2).
