Take-aways:

- Preoccupation with the world (self) is a wasted life! (34, 36) "If anyone wants to come after Me, he must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow Me." (vs. 34)

"For what does it benefit a person to gain the whole world, and forfeit his soul? For what could a person give in exchange for his soul?" (vs. 36-37)
