Psalm 2

Discussion Questions:

- 4) What does it mean to take refuge in God?
- 5) What are some different ways practically that you can take refuge in God?
- 6) What do you think it looks like to "Worship the LORD with *reverence* and rejoice with *trembling*?"
- 7) How does it feel to know that you'll never have to experience God's wrath?
- 8) Specifically, how would tomorrow look different if you were able to keep those thoughts with you at the front of your mind all day?
- 9) Did you learn anything new about God, who He is, what He is like or how to live for Him?
